

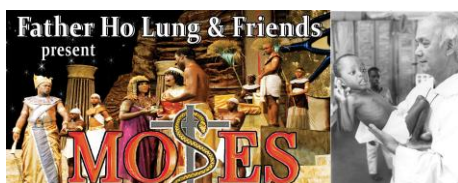


PRINCIPAL'S MID-TERM NEWSLETTER
